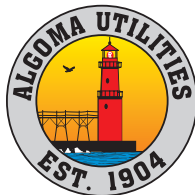

HOME BUYER ASSISTANCE
*DOOR, KEWAUNEE, MANITOWOC &
SHEBOYGAN COUNTIES*

Partners' Homebuyer Assistance programs provide low and moderate-income homebuyers with financial assistance to cover the upfront costs of acquiring a single-family home, such as down payment and closing costs.

To qualify:

- Must earn less than 80% of the County Median Income
- Must have already secured mortgage financing
- Must be purchasing a single-family home.
- Must be able to contribute a minimum of \$1,000 towards the purchase of the home
- Must agree to complete a HUD approved homebuyer education and counseling course
- The value of the purchase price of the home must be below HUD county limits

CRITICAL HOME REPAIRS
*DOOR, KEWAUNEE, MANITOWOC, CALUMET &
SHEBOYGAN COUNTIES*

Partners' Home Rehabilitation Program provides individuals who own and occupy a single-family home assistance to cover the costs of repairs and maintenance issues, as well as accessibility modifications.

To qualify:

- Must earn less than 80% of the County Median Income
- Must own and occupy a single-family home.
- Property value must be below HUD county limits
- Must be current on tax and mortgage payments
- Property must be covered by a homeowner's insurance policy
- Project must meet affordability and loan-to-value guidelines
