

# Algoma Utilities/WPPI Energy **Public Power Scholarship**

## Eligibility guidelines

1. High school seniors may submit an essay to win a **\$500** scholarship. The students (or their parent or legal guardian) must be a customer of Algoma Utilities. Dependents of utility personnel are not eligible.
2. High school seniors must plan to attend a two-year technical college or a four-year university.
3. Scholarship applicants shall compose an essay of 500-1000 words that addresses the following topic: ***Our Community Connection: The Value of Our Municipal Utility.***

The essay should be typed and double-spaced. The essay will be assessed based on the following:

- The quality of the applicant's writing, including spelling, punctuation, grammar, and citing of references;
- The student's ability to provide thoughtful insights and opinions regarding the topic;
- The student's ability to convey clear, concise ideas and conclusions through his/her writing;

Include the following information on a cover page:

- Student's first and last name
  - Name of two-year technical college or four-year University planning to attend
  - Intended field of study
  - Home address
  - Phone number
  - Name of parents or legal guardian
  - Utility account information (name on account, billing address, account number)
4. Deadline for submitting essays is April 26, 2021. Please submit essay and cover page information to: Algoma Utilities, 1407 Flora Ave., Algoma, WI 54201, Attn: Energy Services Manager or e-mail to [mbscherer@wppienergy.org](mailto:mbscherer@wppienergy.org).
